

Appleton Lock 3 Lock Keeper's House

This two story lock keeper's house was constructed by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers in 1892.

It was occupied by lock tenders for Appleton Locks #2 and #3 from 1892 until 1983 when the Corps of Engineers ceased lock operation for commercial navigation.

This structure is on the National Register and is undergoing exterior renovation.
