

 - 1. 2017: Smith-Root developed an electrical barrier design
 - 2. 2018-2019: Smith-Root submitted a 60% design for an electric barrier, along with an operational manual (drawings/specs)
 - a. Submitted to DNR
 - i. DNR returned with questions regarding goby and electrical barrier to evaluate information

- b. 2019: Kleinschmidt proposed to study electrical threshold and swim speed
- c. 2020-2021: Study complete
 - i. Unable to spawn in lab
 - ii. Went out to get goby eggs to hatch
 - iii. Results submitted in draft form, then final form
 - 1. Electrical barrier effective from adult to small size
 - 2. Electrical barrier less of a deterrent to small goby, lesser effect
 - 3. Gobies are not easy to kill
 - 4. Other technologies paired with electrical barriers may have a better effect on smaller fish
 - a. Downstream flow lower lock gate, flushing twice
 - i. Sweep out weaker swimmers
 - b. Benthic sill (low wall) pair with electrical barrier
 - Goby hangs out on bottom during day, stay in general area until bigger length
 - c. Lights paired with electrical barrier
 - Goby typically stay near the bottom during the day and come up when dark
 - ii. Theory, not proven
 - d. Bubble Barrier
 - i. Causes noise and turbulence
 - ii. Less optimal conditions for goby to swim through
 - iii. Not proven
 - e. Expand electrical barrier to cover a larger portion of the water's surface
 - iv. Next Steps
 - 1. Update 60% conceptual design
 - a. Smith-Root revising their plan from three years ago may be more cost efficient
 - b. No engineers on staff
 - c. Kleinschmidt would sub-contract to Smith-Root
 - 2. Update operational/maintenance manual
 - v. Motion made to approve Phil Ramlet to request proposal from Jason Kent from Kleinschmidt as follows
 - 1. Revise 60% conceptual design
 - 2. Update operational/maintenance manual
 - 3. Construction costs
 - 4. Scope of Work
 - 5. Operational Costs
 - 6. To be received by end of March 2023
 - a. Motion made by Tim Short, seconded by Bruce Enke, all approve, Jean Romback-Bartels abstains from voting
 - vi. Proposal to be shared with DNR for feedback
 - 1. DNR cannot know what is acceptable, or requires permits, until they have updated design and operations manual.
