 - iii. DNR was not included in this discussion or notified by ACOE
 - 1. DNR was told by ACOE that cleanup would start this summer
 - a. FRNSA was not made aware of any cleanup plans by ACOE
 - 2. What is ACOE's intent with installing fence
 - a. Long term fix?
 - b. Need to cleanup contamination so FRNSA can use the dry dock intended
